

O diretor-geral da Agência Nacional do Petróleo, Gás Natural e Biocombustíveis (ANP), Décio Oddone, disse que existe a percepção de que o petróleo é um produto a caminho da obsolescência, porem a sociedade brasileira e mundial não estão preparadas para abrir mão do petróleo de uma hora para outra. Ele projeta que nas próximas décadas a matriz energética mundial será cada vez mais limpa e diversificada, com crescente presença de gás natural e de energias renováveis.

"Veremos diversificação como nunca foi vista e outros países vão se aproximar de uma matriz mais limpa como a nossa. Dentro desse ambiente, a sociedade não tem como abrir mão de combustíveis fósseis", analisou Oddone. após a 16º rodada de licitações, realizada na última quinta-feira (10). O diretor-geral da agência defendeu que os leilões são um instrumento estratégico para gerar emprego, renda e desenvolvimento ao país,

Na ocasião, o ministro de minas e energia, Bento Albuquerque, falou que a transição energética no Brasil começou há mais de 40 anos com a construção da hidrefétrica binacional de Itaipu e, anos depois, teve sequência com lançamento de programas de biocombustíveis, como o Pró-Álcool. Segundo o ministro, essas transformações demonstram o quanto a matriz energética brasileira é uma das mais limpas do mundo.
